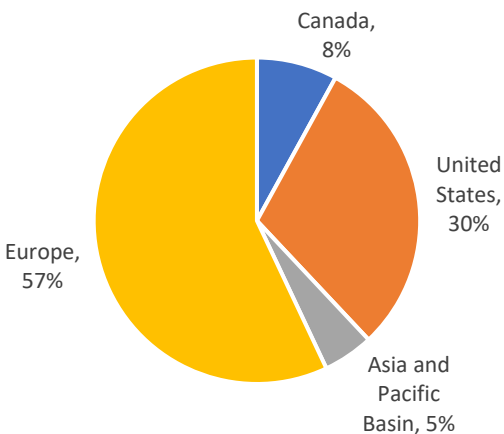

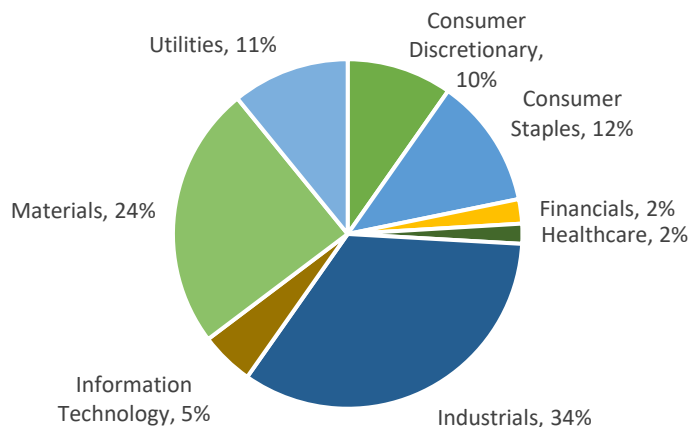

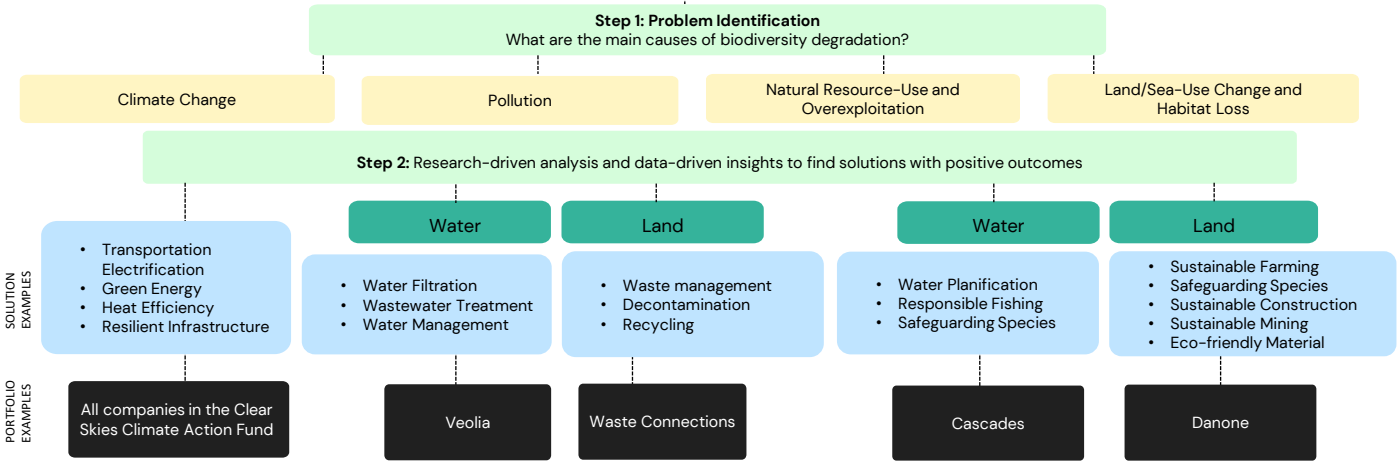

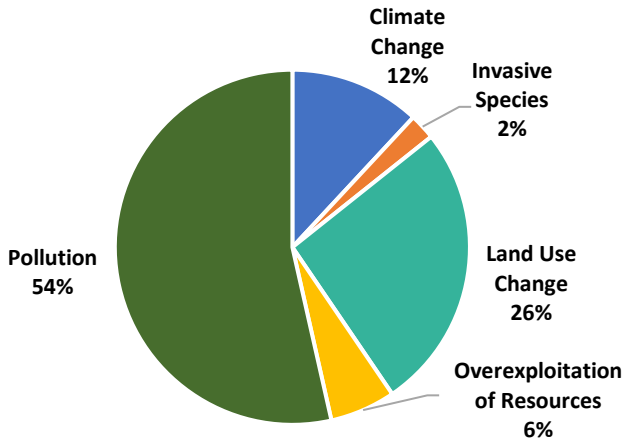

## Theory of Change

Clear Skies seeks out companies actively addressing the five key drivers of biodiversity loss identified by the Intergovernmental Science-Policy Platform on Biodiversity and Ecosystem Services (IPBES) :

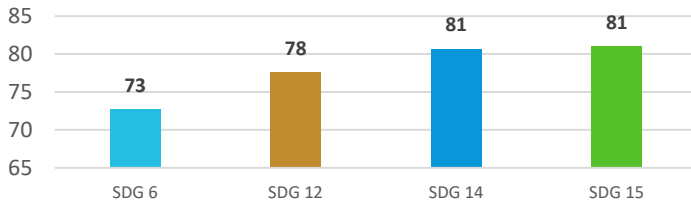
- Land and sea use change
- Overexploitation of resources
- Climate change
- Pollution
- Invasive species

We emphasize companies that have a positive influence across their supply chains, recognizing the broader, system-wide change needed to restore and protect nature. This theory of change aligns directly with our “Preserving the Planet” impact investment theme and supports its key Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), specifically SDG 6, SDG 12, SDG 14 and SDG 15.



The SDG Goal scores of the portfolio are an average of all the companies that disclosed sustainability information in the Fund. For example, a score of 81 for SDG 14 indicates that on average, the companies in the Fund are at the 81st percentile among their peers with regards to their performance on SDG 14 alignment.

## CASE STUDY: Biodiversity Impact Snapshot



GSK (GlaxoSmithKline) is a global medicines and vaccines company. Its biodiversity impact is centered around cleaner water, lower nature pressure from inputs, and habitat improvements at operational sites.

### Freshwater and pollution

- >99% of GSK sites and key suppliers had API (Active Pharmaceutical Ingredient) discharges below no-effect concentration limits in 2024.
- 100% of GSK-owned sites stayed within the limits.
- 100% of sites maintained good water stewardship status in 2024.
- Overall operational water use is down 28% vs 2020, including a further 5% reduction in 2024 vs 2023.

### Land and habitat restoration

- 6 priority sites near Protected Areas and Key Biodiversity Areas.
- 66% of sites have biodiversity management plans in 2024 (+45% vs 2023).

### Sustainable sourcing and deforestation risk

- GSK identified 12 priority nature-dependent materials; 58% of spending on these materials is covered by an action plan for sustainable sourcing by 2030.
- In 2024, 93% of paper packaging came from certified or recycled sources, and 93% of core palm oil materials were third-party certified.

### Oceans and marine biodiversity

- Target: 100% sustainable sourcing of key marine-derived materials by 2030
